## NEEDLES

1 pair 7 mm (no 2) (USA 10 $1 / 2$ ) needles
Cable needle

FASTENER $1 \times$ Kilt pin 00414 or 00412

## TENSION

17 sts and 16 rows to 10 cm measured over cable patt and 14 sts and 16 rows to 10 cm measured over basket patt using 7 mm (USA 10¹22) needles

## SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

$\mathbf{C} 3 \mathbf{B}=$ slip next st onto cable needle and hold at back of work, K 2 , then K 1 from cable needle; $\mathbf{C} \mathbf{3 F}=$ slip next 2 sts onto cable needle and hold at front of work, K1, then K2 from cable needle; $\mathbf{C} 4 \mathbf{B}=$ slip next 2 sts onto a cable needle and hold at
back of work, K2, then K2 from cable needle; C8B=slip next 4 sts onto a cable needle and hold at back of work, K4, then K4 from cable needle; $\mathbf{T} 3 \mathbf{F}=$ slip next 2 sts onto cable needle and hold at front of work, P1 then K2 from cable needle; T3B=slip next st onto cable needle and hold at back of work, K2 then P1 from cable needle

## FRONTS (Both alike)

Using 7mm (USA 10½) needles cast on 15 [16: 17: 19] sts using yarn B, 12 [14: 16:18] sts using yarn A and 15 [16:17: 19] sts using yarn C. 42 [46:50:56] sts.
Next row (WS): K15 [16:17:19] using yarn C, K12 [14: 16: 18] using yarn A and K15 [16:17:19] sts using yarn B.
This row sets intarsia sequence.
Working in intarsia sequence as described in information page proceed as follows:-
Row 1 (RS): P5 [5: 6: 7], C3B, C3F, P4 [5: 5: 6] using yarn B, P2 [3: 4:5], K8, P2 [3: 4:5] using yarn A, P4 [5:5:6], C3B, C3F, P5 [5: 6: 7] using yarn C.
Row 2 and every foll alt row: Keeping intarsia sequence, K the knit sts, P the purl sts.
Row 3: P4 [4: 5: 6], C3B, K2, C3F, P3 [4: 4:5] using yarn B, P2 [3: 4: 5], C8B, P2 [3: 4:5] using yarn A, P3 [4: 4:5], C3B, K2, C3F, P4 [4:5:6] using yarn C.
Row 5: P3 [3: 4:5], C3B, K4, C3F, P2 [3:3:4] using yarn B, P2 [3: 4: 5], K8, P2 [3: 4:5] using yarn A, P2 [3: 3: 4], C3B, K4, C3F, P3 [3: 4:5] using yarn C.
Row 7: P2 [2: 3: 4], C3B, K6, C3F, P1 [2: 2: 3] using yarn B, P2 [3: 4: 5], K8, P2 [3: 4:5] using yarn A, P1 [2: 2: 3], C3B, K6, C3F, P2 [2: 3: 4] using yarn C.
Row 9: P2 [2: 3: 4], T3F, K6, T3B, P1 [2: 2: 3] using yarn B, P2 [3: 4: 5], K8, P2 [3: 4: 5] using yarn A, P1 [2: 2: 3], T3F, K6,

T3B, P2 [2: 3: 4] using yarn C.
Row 11: P3 [3: 4:5], T3F, K4, T3B, P2 [3:3:4] using yarn B, P2 [3: 4: 5], C8B, P2 [3: 4:5] using yarn A, P2 [3: 3: 4] T3F, K4, T3B, P3 [3: 4:5] using yarn C.
Row 13: P4 [4: 5: 6], T3F, K2, T3B, P3 [4: 4:5] using yarn B, P2 [3: 4: 5], K8, P2 [3: 4: 5] using yarn A, P3 [4: 4:5],T3F, K2, T3B, P4 [4:5:6] using yarn C.
Row 15: P5 [5: 6: 7], T3F, T3B, P4 [5: 5: 6] using yarn B, P2 [3: 4:5], K8, P2 [3: 4: 5] using yarn A, P4 [5: 5: 6], T3F, T3B, P5 [5: 6:7] using yarn C.
Row 17: P6 [6:7:8], C4B, P5 [6: 6:7] using yarn B, P2 [3: 4: 5], K8, P2 [3: 4:5] using yarn A, P5 [6: 6:7], C4B, P6 [6:7:8] using yarn C .
Row 19: P5 [5: 6: 7], C3B, C3F, P4 [5: 5: 6] using yarn B, P2 [3: 4: 5], K8, P2 [3: 4:5] using yarn A, P4 [5: 5: 6], C3B, C3F, P5 [5: 6: 7] using yarn C.
Row 21: P4 [4:5:6], C3B, K2, C3F, P3 [4: 4:5] using yarn B, P2 [3: 4: 5], K8, P2 [3: 4: 5] using yarn A, P3 [4: 4:5], C3B, K2, C3F, P4 [4: 5: 6] using yarn C.
Row 23: P4 [4:5:6], T3F, K2, T3B, P3 [4: 4:5] using yarn B, P2 [3: 4: 5], K8, P2 [3: 4:5] using yarn A, P3 [4: 4:5],T3F, K2, T3B, P4 [4: 5: 6] using yarn C.
Row 25: P5 [5: 6: 7], T3F, T3B, P4 [5: 5: 6] using yarn B, P2 [3: 4: 5], K8, P2 [3: 4: 5] using yarn A, P4 [5: 5: 6], T3F, T3B, P5 [5: 6: 7] using yarn C.
Row 27: P6 [6:7:8], C4B, P5 [6: 6:7] using yarn B, P2 [3: 4: 5], K8, P2 [3: 4:5] using yarn A, P5 [6: 6:7], C4B, P6 [6:7:8] using yarn C.
Row 28: K6 [6: 7: 8], P4, K5 [6: 6: 7] using yarn C, K2 [3: 4: 5], P8, K2 [3: 4:5] using yarn A, K5 [6: 6: 7], P4, K6 [6: 7: 8] using yarn B .
These 28 rows form cable patt.
Cont in cable patt until work meas 49 [51:53:55] cm, ending with RS facing for next row.
Cast off in intarsia sequence.

BACK
Cast on 68 [76:84:92] sts using 7 mm (USA 10122) needles and yarn A.
Row 1 (RS): Knit.
Row 2: Purl.
Row 3: ${ }^{\star} \mathrm{K} 2$, P 2 , rep from ${ }^{\star}$ to end.
Row 4: As row 3.
Row 5: Knit.
Row 6: Purl.
Row 7: ${ }^{\star} \mathrm{P} 2$, K2, rep from ${ }^{\star}$ to end.
Row 8: As row 7.
These 8 rows form basket patt.
Cont in basket patt until back meas 49 [ $51: 53: 55] \mathrm{cm}$, ending with RS facing for next row. Cast off.

## SLEEVES (Both alike)

Cast on 44 [46: 48:50] sts using 7 mm
(USA 10 12 ) needles and yarn A.
Cont in basket patt as given for back shaping sides by inc 1 st at each end of 5th and every foll 4th row to 72 [74: 76: 78] sts, then every foll alt row to 84 [86: 88: 90] sts working inc sts in patt.
Cont straight in basket patt until sleeve meas
45 [46: 47: 47] cm, ending with RS facing for next row. Cast off.

## MAKING UP

Pin out pieces and cover with a dampcloth, leave until dry. Join shoulder seams (centre front edges of fronts will meet at centre back) using mattress stitch.
Place markers 30 [31:32:33] cm down from shoulder seam. Join sleeve to body between markers.
Join underarm and side seams.
